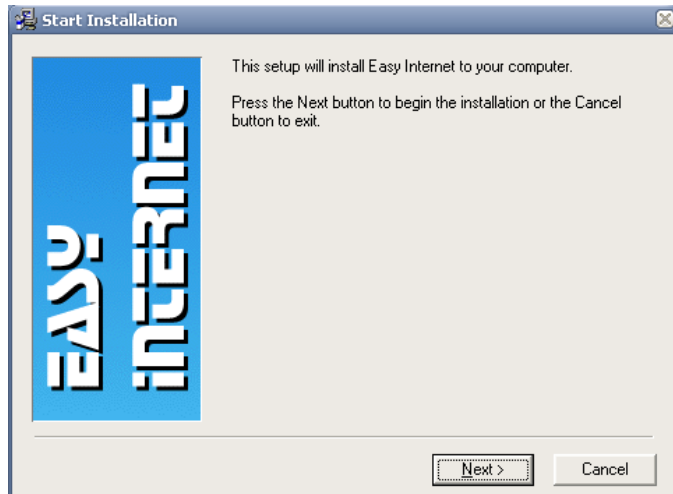


Internet Express Easy Internet

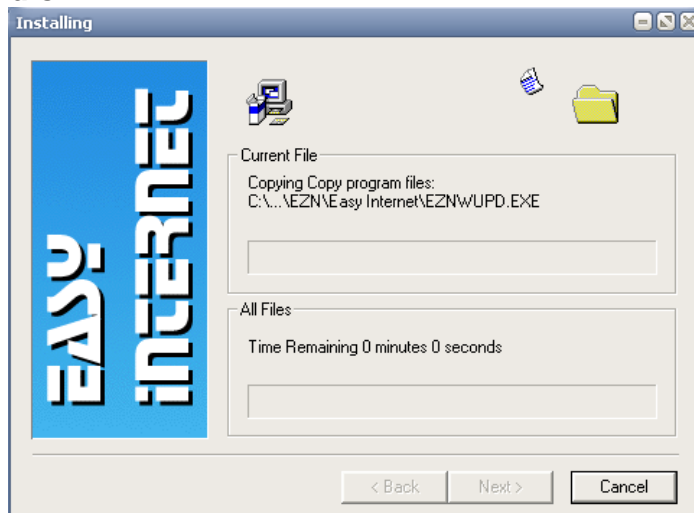
Configuring Easy Internet

Below is the process for setting up your dialup and e-mail account(s) using the Easy Internet setup wizard provided with the Internet Express software disc..

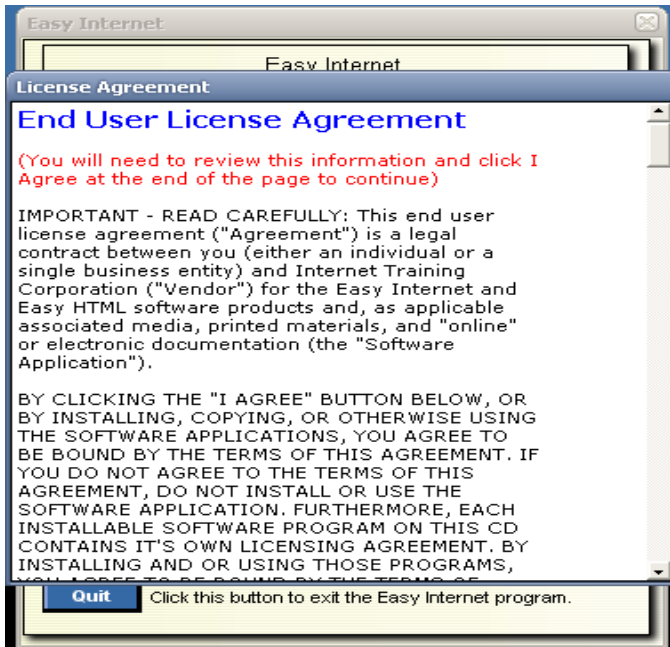
Start the installation by placing the disc in your CD-ROM drive. If the installer doesn't automatically start, double click on "My Computer", then double click on your CD-ROM drive. Press "Next" once the installer has started.



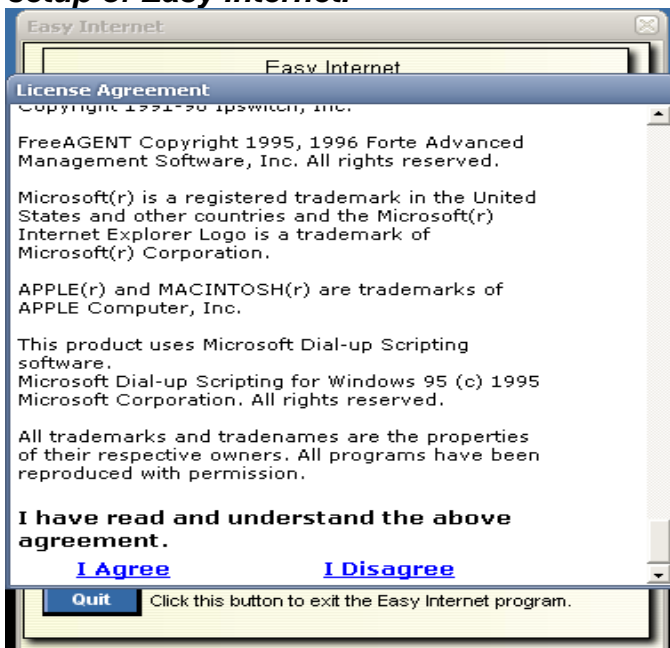
The installer will start copying the necessary files from the CD to your hard disk.



You will need to scroll down to the bottom of the EULA in order to continue.



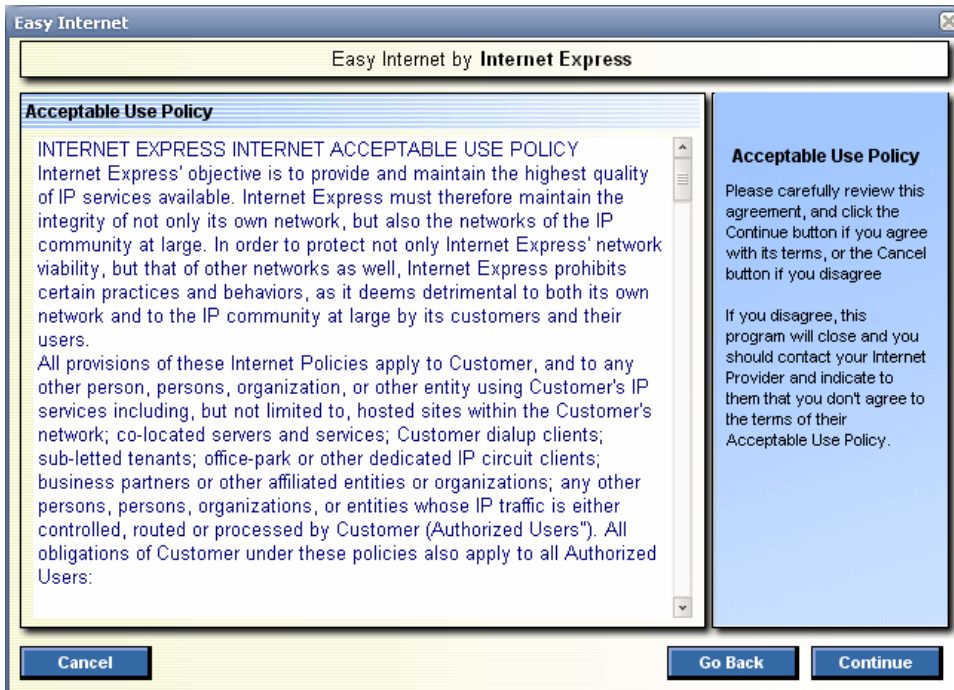
Left click on the "I Agree" text at the bottom of the EULA to continue the setup of Easy Internet.



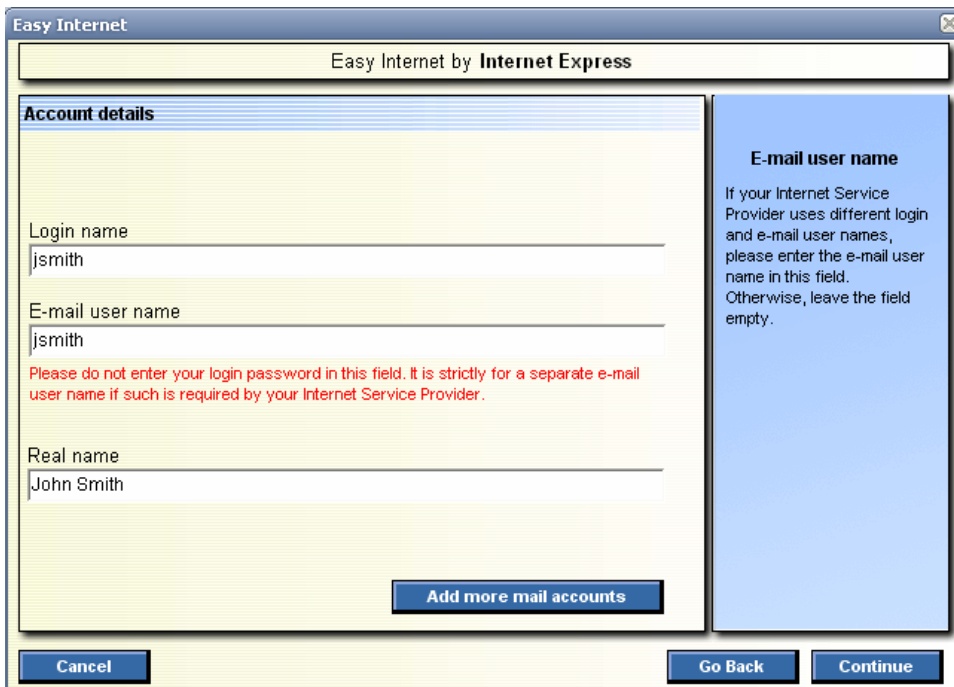
You will see the Welcome to Internet Express splash screen after you have accepted the EULA.



You will need to accept the Internet Express Acceptable Use Policy in order to proceed.



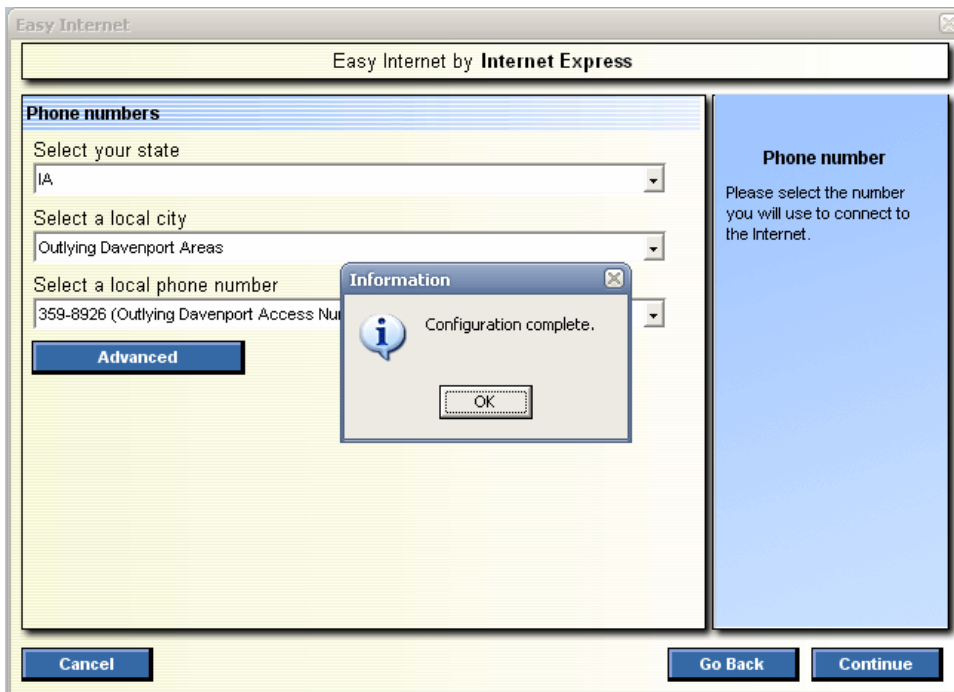
You will enter your login name, e-mail user name (many times it is the same as the login), and your real name. Note: login names are case sensitive and usually will be entered in all lower case. Press "Continue" in order to proceed.



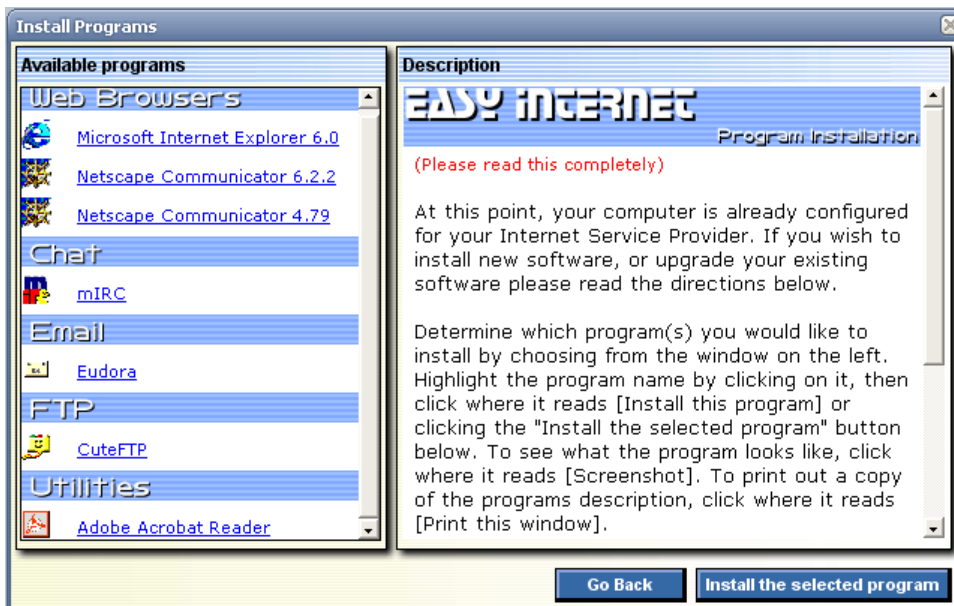
Select the state you will be using the service from along with the city. If you are able to dial into Moline, IL locally you can choose the Quad Cities Metro Area option. You can choose the "Advanced" button to manually enter a telephone number if you're outside the Quad Cities local service area.

There is also an Internet Tutorial included on the CD which will explain the basics of Internet use such as web browsing, e-mail, and FTP file transfer.

You can access the tutorial by clicking the "Internet Tutorial, help" button on the main menu of the Easy Internet setup.
